The reading theme for this year is Treasure a Good Book. The Basic Program procedures and preschool was discussed. Some of the special needs children arrive to school by school vans. Many children are served breakfast each day. The Morningside Women's basketball team came to the school to spend three hours with the students. Co-teaching math is done by Mrs. Berthusen and Mrs. Baker for the 2nd graders. The 2nd grade teachers break into groups of three teachers to teach math to the students. Use of the Chrome books was demonstrated during a math session. Mrs. Olsen works with her students on a Read-to-Self teaching. Mrs. Bak works on small group instruction with reading. Mrs. Riediger teaches in a self-contained special ed classroom. Daycare runs a pseudo preschool. The Daily Five was discussed. Mrs. Weeks was shown teaching how to read non-fiction text. Numerous other teachers and settings were shown.
